"Thalia comes from the Greek word thalia, an adjectival term used to describe banquets as rich, plentiful, luxuriant and abundant. Thalia was the goddess of festivity and rich, luxurious banquets. She was one of the three Kharites who usually appears with her sisters dancing in a circle. The Oracle Audio Thalia phono cartridge is a high-output, moving-coil, ebony wood bodied cartridge designed and voiced with the Oracle Audio Delphi MKV, Oracle Audio/SME 345 tone arm and the Oracle Audio Temple PH 1000 phono stage.
